- **Education** – courses, seminars, conferences providing practical hands-on teaching and policy discussions.

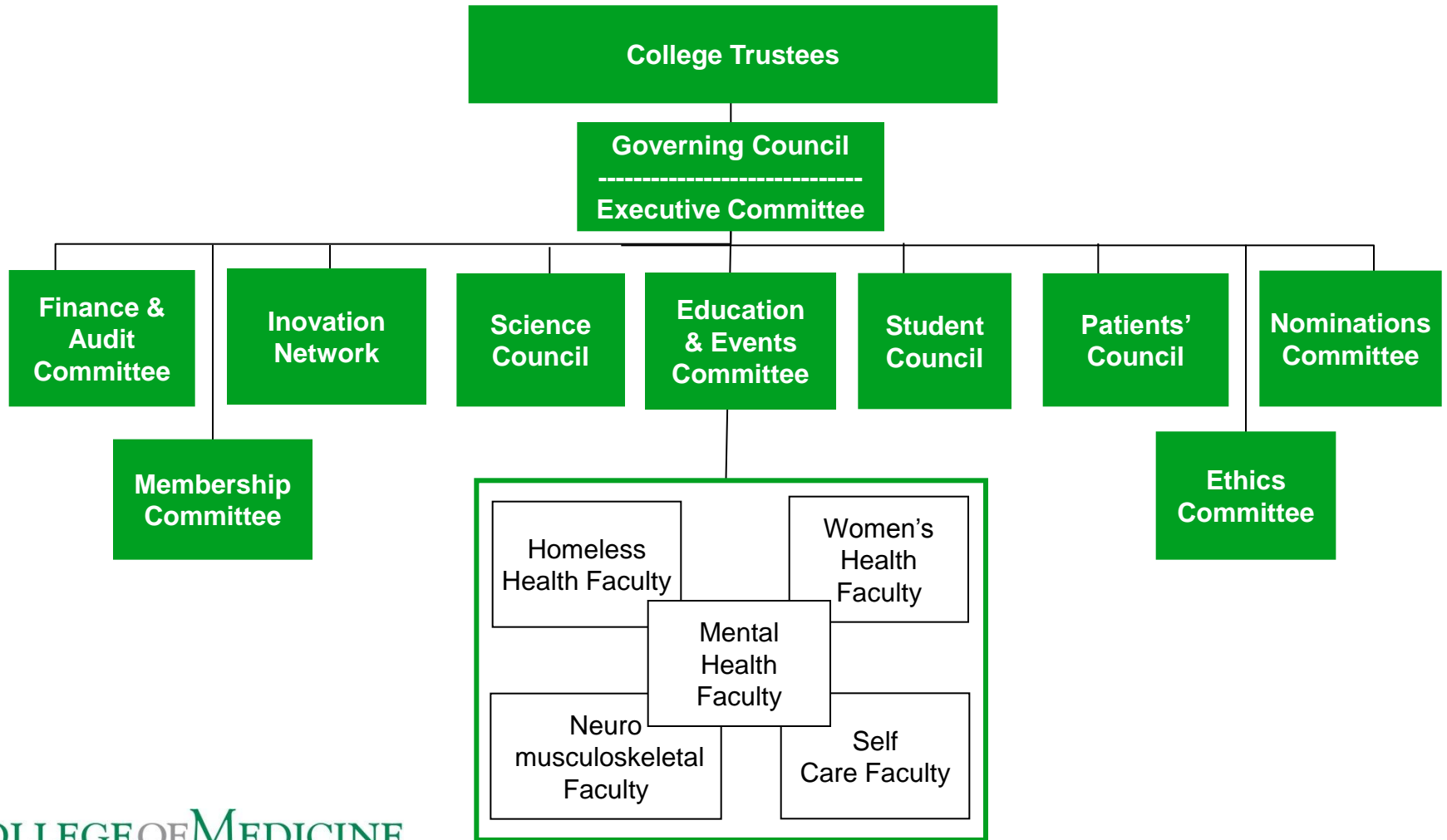


Putting Philosophy into Practice
