There are also lockers available for short term use.</p> <p>Disabled Facilities and access</p> <p>There is disabled access available in all of our lecture theatres, and all of our meeting rooms at 1 Wimpole St. If you anticipate hosting guests with more serious mobility issues, we recommend they bring their own assistants as the society does not have qualified minders on site.</p> <p>All lecture theatres are equipped with hearing aid loops to assist guests with hearing difficulties.</p> <p>Parking</p> <p>There is no parking available on-site at 1 Wimpole St. There are limited street parking spaces available in the surrounding area, as well as numerous parking structures close by, including one in Cavendish Square, directly behind the Society.</p> <p>Photography Permission must be given by 1 Wimpole St with regards to any recordings photographic, video, audio, or otherwise made at all events at Chandos House, or 1 Wimpole St. signage</p> <p>Smoking</p> <p>The Society operates under a strict non-smoking policy in all of its areas. Delegates and guests should please refrain from smoking on the pavement directly outside the doors.</p> <p>Reception/security</p> <p>Our reception desk is manned Monday through Friday from 8am to 6 pm, any A charging facility is also available for mobile devices in our cloakroom. Wi-Fi</p> <p>The connection speed/bandwidth at 1 Wimpole St is 50Mb/s for upload and download. The available bandwidth for Wi-Fi use is set at 20Mb/s.</p> <p>Please note bandwidth is shared with the whole building and therefore traffic is variable. 
Emergency Procedures

If you hear the Fire alarm The initial fire bell will sound first, this will be followed by an announcement on the PA system. The cause will be investigated, and in the event of a fire, an evacuation call on the PA will follow. Please take no action until the order to evacuate the building (if necessary) is given. In the event of an evacuation order Please leave the building in an orderly fashion by the nearest exit. All fire evacuation routes are clearly marked.

Please make sure all of your delegates are aware of the nearest fire evacuation route.

Ensure all members of your group or area are accounted for. If you have disabled persons within that group, please make sure they have the appropriate assistance and inform us beforehand. Follow any instructions given by staff, or Fire marshal. Please proceed to the assembly point in Cavendish square and await further instruction.

<p>Transportation:</p>	<p>By London Underground The RSM is a ten minute walk from Oxford Circus (Victoria, Bakerloo and Central lines) and a five minute walk from Bond Street Station (Central and Jubilee lines).</p> <p>Oxford Circus is a five minute tube journey from Victoria, five minutes from Marylebone and 12 minutes from King's Cross St Pancras. From Waterloo, Bond Street is a five minute tube journey on the Jubilee line.</p> <p>By bus Nearest bus routes are: 6, 7, 10, 13, 15, 23, 25, 30, 55, 73, 94, 98, 113, 137, 139, 159, 175, 189, 274, 390 and are all within walking distance to the RSM.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get help planning your visit to the RSM with Transport for London's Journey Planner • For up to date travel information visit Travel for London <p>By car RSM is in the congestion charging zone.
